The Award represents NOCALL's appreciation and encouragement to continue the valuable advocacy contributions of our colleagues.

This is an opportunity to acknowledge the work of someone in the greater NOCALL community who has been an advocate for law libraries and legal information such as (but not limited to) a legislator, judge, firm partner, academic, or vendor. All nominations are completely confidential.

The Awards Selection Committee consists of three members, with the current past President serving as chair. To be eligible for the Award, a nominee shall have performed work affecting the NOCALL community which directly impacts law librarians, law libraries, or legal information patrons.

Any Chapter member may submit nominations. All Nominations must be accompanied by a brief justification that should describe the achievement(s) or contribution(s) to NOCALL and/or law librarianship or the legal community on which the nomination is based. Also include pertinent biographical data about the nominee. Please include the following as a cover page to the narrative:
