**Final Recommendations for changes to the current NOCALL Constitution**

**Submitted to the NOCALL Membership 03/16/2015**

**Article VIII. Bylaws.**

**Section 1.** Any Bylaw may be adopted, repealed, amended or suspended by a majority vote of those present and voting at any meeting of the Association. (Adopted December 5, 1980)

**Section 2.** Amendments to the Bylaws shall be submitted to the American Association of Law Libraries Committee on Constitution and Bylaws by the President upon adoption by the membership of the Association. (Adopted May 23, 1985)

Change to:

**Article VIII. Bylaws.**

**Section 1.** Any Bylaw may be adopted, repealed, amended or suspended by a majority vote of those present and voting at any meeting of the Association, unless the Executive Board votes to submit amendments to the membership by a distributed ballot. (Proposed December 21, 2014)

**Section 2.** Amendments submitted for approval by a distributed ballot shall be adopted upon approval by a simple majority of the members voting. The Executive Board shall specify the time for closing the balloting, but in no case shall it be less than 15 days after the distribution of the ballot. (Proposed December 21, 2014)

**Section 3.** Amendments to the Bylaws shall be submitted to the American Association of Law Libraries Committee on Constitution and Bylaws by the President upon adoption by the membership of the Association. (Adopted May 23, 1985)
